

Religious Education:

Sacraments- In this unit, the children will think about the nature of vocation. They will learn that a vocation is a strong feeling of calling or suitability for a particular career, occupation or role in life. The Old Testament stories will show how God calls people in faith. Multiplicative Reasoning- The children will be able to explain and understand the relationship between multiplication and division. They will use this understanding to derive facts and solve problems.
