

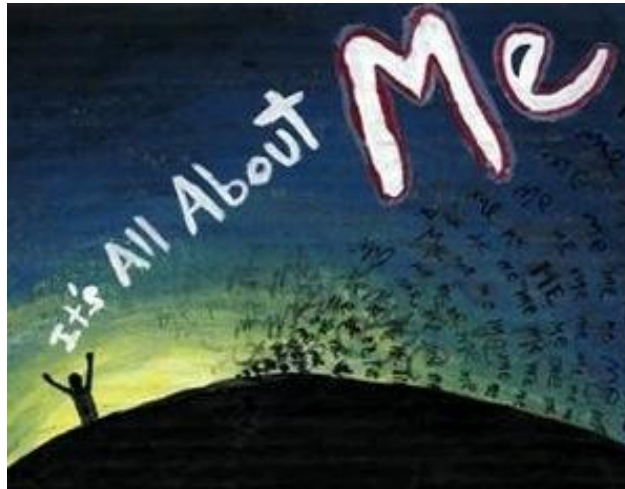
Year 6 Learning Experience Overview - Spring 1

Science

Children will build on their knowledge and understanding of different systems within the body. They will research the parts and functions of the circulatory system. They will focus on how nutrients are transported around the human body. Children will explore how a healthy lifestyle supports the body to function and how different types of drugs affect the body.

Computing

The children will recap on how to stay safe online before moving on to create a television; starting with designing a story board and then filming their own creations.



Geography

We will find out about the human and physical features of our local area. The children will learn about the UK's economic activity, land use, settlements, climate, upland areas and England's longest rivers which will then all be compared to the area in which we live.

Music

All the learning in this unit is focused around the song: I'll Be There by 'The Jackson 5'. We will also learn about Michael Jackson, his music and how he contributed to the development of pop music.

DT

This 'Super Seasonal Cooking' unit of work will teach the children about the importance of buying seasonal food. The first part of the unit provides an opportunity to learn where, when and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed. Children will then have the chance to sample some spring seasonal food before designing their own balanced seasonal meal. They will learn how to cook with the seasonal ingredients following their own recipes and using a wide range of preparation and cooking techniques. Finally, children will evaluate their product against their design criteria. Children will learn appropriate hygiene rules for handling meat and fish and safe preparation skills.
